Multi-Mino can be used on all crops and in combination with most organic and synthetic fertilizers. Multi-Mino contains Zinc, Iron, Manganese, Copper, Boron, Molybdenum, Magnesium and Nitrogen in a balanced rate which are all essential for plant growth. The micronutrients in Multi-Mino are amino acid complexed. Multi-Mino should be used to correct micronutrient deficiencies in the crop/soil.

Warning: Contains Boron. Do not use on sensitive crops. Use only according to manufacturer's directions. The use of this material on any crops other than those recommended may result in injury.


